WHO WE ARE LOOKING FOR

McMahon Services Demolition Division in partnership with Renewal SA's Works Program are looking for motivated and committed people living in Adelaide, who are keen to start a career as a Demolition Technician.

This opportunity has been made possible by the inclusion of an economic development commitment in the Lot Fourteen Stage 3A Demolition contract, seeking to provide work experience and traineeships.

Women and Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander people are encouraged to apply.

Participants must attend information and selection sessions, commit to a one-week work experience placement and have:

- ▶ A reasonable level of fitness
- ▶ The right to work in Australia
- ▶ Sound literacy and numeracy skills
- ▶ A current SA Driver's Licence and reliable vehicle.

Additional eligibility criteria apply.

WHAT YOU CAN ACHIEVE

Participants will perform a one-week work experience placement on a live demolition site.

Up to six successful participants will have the opportunity to complete a Certificate III Demolition (CPC30413) traineeship while employed full time with McMahon Services Australia.

Trainees will receive on the job training while working for a company that embraces diversity and fosters its employees for long-term career progression. Trainees will also have the opportunity to complete a variety of nationally accredited units such as:
